

Diwali 2011 Guidelines

IANH Diwali festival will be held on October 29th at Nashua High School North. Registration will be open from September 1st to September 15th through the IANH website.

Please refer participation guidelines below:

1. Registrations will be accepted for group items only. Each participant can take part in only one group item. Solo items for the Diwali festival can be performed only upon invitation by the IANH cultural committee.
2. The minimum age of participants is 8 years.
3. IANH encourages a variety of items. Maximum allowed time for Bollywood dance is 5 minutes. Allowed time for other items like group music rendition, classical dance, skit, dance drama etc is 7-10 minutes. Entries exceeding the time limit will not be allowed.
4. IANH website will be set up for registering entries. The site will be open for registration on September 1st 2011 and registrations can be entered till September 15th, 2011. Unfortunately, no request will be entertained after that date.
5. Please send in details about the program with the name of the item, short description (about the dance/music or the author and story of skit/drama), approximate duration, teacher/choreographer's/ Director's name & telephone number, participants' names and their ages. It is important that you provide all the details about your item accurately without typos. Please upload only good quality music files in MP3 format when registering.
6. Please send in a sample video of your performance (upto 1 min clip) by email to cultural@ianh.org by September 15th 2011. This is for IANH to screen the entries and select the final list of performances. Entries without a sample video will not be considered for selection.
7. A maximum of 25 entries will be selected out of the total number of entries received. IANH cultural committee's decision is final.
8. The cultural committee will inform registrants if their entry is in the final list by September 20th, and give an approximate time slot for each selected item by September 30th. Requests to move the sequence of items will not be entertained.
9. Please do not make any final arrangements for your performance until your entry has been confirmed as selected.
10. Volunteering for IANH events is a noble act. Youth volunteers and parents, please indicate in the registration if you would be willing to volunteer. You could also send in independent entries for just volunteering, by mentioning so, in one of the 'notes' fields.
11. There is a participation fee of \$10 for each participant. Participation fee for IANH members is \$5 for each participant. Participation fee includes admission to the event, including Gharba. Please send your check for participation fee payable to IANH to Vandana Dhakar, Membership Secretary, 20 Chad Road, Manchester, NH 03104 ASAP after your entry has been accepted.
