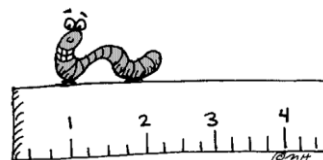

**Goal of the workshops:** Math, like any other skill, can be mastered by patient, consistent practice. But the practice does not have to be boring- in fact, the opposite is true. Children will feel excited when they are exposed to a multitude of problems and the various techniques used to solve them. We hope to kindle that excitement and interest throughout our workshops. We will also review some techniques for preparing for math contests, but that is not the main goal of the workshop.

**About the classes:** Our class sizes will be limited to a maximum of 12 students per group. For Group 1, we would like to give preference to 3<sup>rd</sup> and 4<sup>th</sup> graders who may not have been exposed to some math concepts that fifth graders may already know. Group 2 will have students mainly from grades 4 and 5.

A problem set will be given on each day and homework will be assigned at the end of the first day of the workshop. A third review session may be scheduled in February based on the interest of the students.

Each day will end with some fun math games. Some light snacks and juice will be provided during a break.

**The Teachers:** Lasya and Anish Thilagar, who are in 11<sup>th</sup> and 8<sup>th</sup> grade respectively, are passionate about math and would love to share their interest with other children. They have both excelled at various state level math competitions, attended various math camps and have conducted similar math workshops in the past.
